

Summary of Curriculum Vitae

Jaime Gil Aluja (Reus, 1936) doctor in Economic Science at the University of Barcelona and Professor of Finance and Economy at this same university. He forms part of the first group to obtain a degree in this Catalan teaching and research centre. With a teaching career of over forty five years, Professor Gil Aluja has obtained international scientific recognition.

He is President of the Royal Academy of Economic and Financial Science (Spain) and Vice-president Of The Royal Academy of Doctors (Spain). He, also, is an academic of the most prestigious institutions, such as the Rumanian Academy (Rumania), Delphinal Academy (France), Academy of Natural Science (Russia), International Academy of Information Science (Russia) and Byelorussia Academy of Engineering (Byelorussia). He has been named Doctor ‘Honoris Causa’ by the following universities: University of Buenos Aires (Argentina), University of Sophia (Bulgaria), State University of Byelorussia (Minsk), University of Santiago de Cuba (Cuba), University of Reggio Calabria (Italy), University of Vigo (Spain), University Rovira y Virgili (Spain), University of Lipetsk (Russia), State University of Nicolaev (Ukraine), University of Perpignan (France), University of Leon (Spain), University of La Reunion (France), University of Bordeaux (France), University of Messina (Italy), University of Astana (Kazakhstan) and University of Gerona (Spain).

He has been distinguished both at national and international levels with the Great Cross of Alfonso X ‘El Sabio’ (Spain), Moisil Medal (Rumania), Calabria Prize (Italy), Official of the Order of Academic Palmes (France), Chevalier of Order of Civil Merit (France), Commander of the Order of Throne (Marroc), Medal of Bicentenary (Venezuela), Medal of Gold of Creta (Greece), Medal from the University of Barcelona (Spain), Medal from the Academy of Montpellier (France), Medal from the Mediterranean University of Reggio Calabria (Italy), Medal from the University of Bordeaux (France), the International Kaufmann Award (Spain) and gold and brilliant Medal of F.C. Barcelona (Spain).

He is a member of international teaching and research organisations and is President of the International Society for Fuzzy Management and Economy (SIGEF) and of the Association for the Advancement of Modelling and Simulation Techniques in Enterprises (AMSE), as well as Vice-president of the European Association for Company Management and Economy (AEDEM), Member of the Conseil Scientifique et de Recherche de l’INSEAC of Bordeaux, Member of the Consultant Board of the Higher Institute of Applied Economy (ISEA) of Barcelona, and Member of the International Advisory Committee of the International School for Information Technology (ISIT) of Andhra Pradesh (India). He is considered the father of the new theory of uncertainty and of the development of multivalent logic in the sphere of economics and management.
